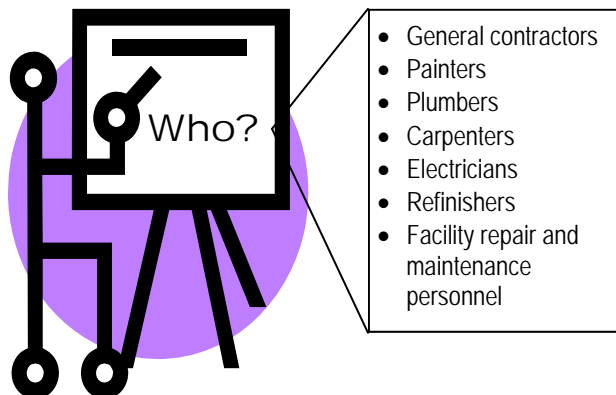


WI Lead Safe Renovator Training

Lead Safe Renovator Refresher

This 4-hour course is designed for persons who have previously completed a WI-Accredited Lead-Safe Work course and wish to update their training to satisfy the training requirement to obtain Wisconsin DHS Lead Safe Renovator Certification. Renovator certification will be required for at least one member of each crew conducting remodeling, renovating or painting activities in pre-1978 dwellings under the new Wisconsin Lead Rule effective April 22, 2010.

(This course also qualifies for 4 CE credits for Dwelling Contractor Qualifier credential holders)

Lead Safe Renovator

This 1-day course is designed for persons who conduct or oversee non-abatement Lead-Based Paint (LBP) activities. This course is required by HUD for persons conducting non-abatement LBP activity as part of a federally funded project. This course also satisfies the training requirement to obtain EPA Renovator Certification that will be required under the new EPA Renovator, Remodeler and Painter (RRP) Rule effective April 22, 2010.

This course is designed to educate attendees how to conduct renovating and remodeling activities in a lead-safe manner. Topics covered include background information on lead, health effects of exposure to lead, regulations, worksite preparation, conducting interim control and non-abatement activities, work site clean-up and disposal. This class satisfies the training requirement to become EPA certified as a Lead Safe Renovator. After April 22, 2010, each crew conducting remodeling, renovating and/or painting activities in homes built before 1978 will have to have at least one member that has completed this training and is certified as a Lead Safe Renovator.

(This course also qualifies for 8 CE credits for Dwelling Contractor Qualifier credential holders)
